

Historic Waldron Building



The Waldron Building, built in 1891, is a registered historic building in the Fairhaven district of Bellingham. It was estimated that the building was probably 10 or 15 years away from completely crumbling. The entire building is currently under renovation. A steel frame was built inside the building and attached to its brick façade to make it earthquake-proof. When complete, the infrastructure that Ebenal construction has installed will keep the building standing, not the original masonry on the outside. The focus is to keep the beauty and ambiance of the building while at the same time getting it up to modern codes. The building will be mixed use with an underground garage.
